HOW TO USE

- Add 2 scoops (1 scoop = 50g) of laundry powder to the wash powder hopper. As a guide, most domestic machines are approximately 5-6Kg.
- **CARE INSTRUCTIONS:** Always follow garment manufacturer's instructions. Do not overload the machine – if in doubt refer to machine manufacturer's guidance. Detergent is not suitable for the following categories: silks and woollens. Do not use for pre-treating stains or allow the powder to remain in contact with damp laundry before starting the wash.
- For best results wash at 40°C or above.
- **Soaking:** Never soak non-colour fast or flame resistant fabrics or garments with metal fasteners.
- **Colour fastness:** If in doubt, simply hand wash the garment first time round with cool water to test for colour loss.

- Keep container tightly closed in a cool dry place and store in a safe manner in a locked storage area away from the general public. Never mix chemicals together or re-fill containers from other vessels or drums.

SAFETY ADVICE

Not classified as hazardous, however we advise that normal cleaning safety practices are adopted. Wear rubber gloves when handling and avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention if irritation persists.
