DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Dilution rates depend on severity of soiling and water conditions, but is recommended that the product is used at a concentration of 1ml/litre.
- Empty glasses before placing into glasswasher.
- Do not put coffee cups, milk glasses or other food crockery into the machine.
- Wash water temperature of 55°C - 70°C gives optimum performance.
- Ensure that the cabinet wash temperature, pressure and volume meet specification.
- Use BHR Rinse aid in final rinse cycle for perfect results. Do not use standard rinse additives as they may leave residues on glass.
- Do not leave washed glasses in the machine.
- Allow time for drying and cooling of glasses.
- Minimise handling of clean glassware and do not touch the lip area of the glass.

STORAGE:

Store in original container and protect from extremes of temperature. Do not store in direct sunlight nor allow the product to freeze. Shelf life (in unopened original container) is a minimum of 18 months.
